HGSF is a charity which makes grants to younger people from "the ancient parish of Hawkshead" to help with education and training expenses. As last year, lower-level grants will also be available to cover transportation costs for 16-18 year olds studying A-levels, 6th form college courses or apprenticeships, recognising that all 16-18 year olds are required to be in education, training or employment and transportation is necessary to reach schools or colleges from Hawkshead. Evidence of enrolment or acceptance on to the course must be provided, and applicants must have been resident in the Ancient Parish of Hawkshead (which includes Monk Coniston, Skelwith, Claife and parts of Grizedale and Satterthwaite, but not Colton) for 3 years.
