**LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972 (SECTION 87(2))
THE LOCAL ELECTIONS (PARISHES AND COMMUNITIES) (ENGLAND
AND WALES) RULES 2006 (RULE 5)**

- (1) There is a vacancy on the above-mentioned Council caused by the resignation of Cllr K Fordham.....
- (2) A by-election to fill the vacancy must be held if, within 14 days form the date of the publishing of this Notice, ten electors for the Parish give notice, in writing to the Returning Officer for their request for an election.
- (3) If a by-election is called it will not be held until 6th May 2021 in line with the Local Government and Police and Crime Commissioner (Coronavirus) (Postponement of Elections and Referendums) (England and Wales) Regulations 2020.
- (4) The Returning Officer for Parish Elections is Simon McVey, South Lakeland District Council, South Lakeland House, Lowther Street, Kendal.
- (5) If no such notice is given, the Parish Council must fill the vacancy by co-option as soon as practicable after the expiry of the period of 14 days referred to at Paragraph (2) above.
