150/2019	<u>Cumbria County Councillor</u> Cllr Brereton apologised for none attendance of last couple of meetings. He reported that he has been in correspondence with the owners of Green Bank regarding vehicles crashing into the wall outside their property and has forwarded correspondence on, he will make sure it is on the Highways agenda. He asked if there were other ongoing issues, Councillors were able to up date that Roger Ground has a grit bin and the road is going to be shut on 21 st when the gullies and other issues are going to be done. The flooding by the YHA is still ongoing – Cllr Brereton advised to make sure we get pictures when it is full – action all. Matt asked that we update him on any new issues or anything which continues to be ongoing. Discussion took place regarding the chippings at Outgate Quarry Matt will continue to pursue the removal of these. It was reported that children have been seen playing on these which is a health and safety issue as it is not completely fenced off, he will feed this back. Cllr Brereton reported that there is a meeting of the Ferry users group coming up. Main concerns were the loss of technical expertise and planning for a replacement. Signage when the Ferry is closed is still an ongoing issue Cllr Brodie is aware of this for the meeting. Jill Haige has plans of producing a leaflet of routes around the area for bikes and pedestrians using the Ferry. Cllr Brereton reported about the Working Together Project – the role of a Lengthsman is on the agenda and the local committee have been doing a trial period working with parishes, National Trust and Lake District National Park Authority they have looked at the repair and maintenance at Tilberthwaite. Template agreements are being looked at for Parish Councils with a Lengthsman and thoughts of the Council receiving a report of what the Lengthsman has done, when and where, ie verges cut, drains being cleared so these are not duplicated. They would then hope to help finance the PC for the work done but this is 18 months – 2 years away.	ALL
